***Tell Congress To Protect
Their Healthcare!***

The majority of America’s 20 million veterans do **not** get their health care from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA). Hundreds of thousands of veterans and their families— including the 1.8 million who are covered by Medicaid--could lose healthcare under the Republican health care repeal bill.

Under the GOP healthcare repeal bill released in the Senate:

- Almost half a million veterans will lose Medicaid coverage by 2026 including 32,000 in Maryland.
- Veterans with **pre-existing conditions**, including those related to their service like amputations, spinal cord injuries, PTSD and related trauma, may have to pay **more** out of pocket for treatment because insurance companies would no longer be required to cover essential health benefits like physical therapy, mental illness and prescriptions.

The bill puts veterans’ healthcare at risk while at the same time providing over **\$600 billion in tax cuts to the richest households, insurance companies and drug manufacturers.**
