



Why Register as an Official SAVE Promise Club?

Whether you have participated as a SAVE chapter in the past, are forming a new SAVE Promise Club in your school or youth organization, or are embedding your SAVE Promise Club efforts into an existing club, such as SADD, Student Council, FCCLA, or another student leadership, civic or kindness club, you are encouraged to sign up as an official SAVE Promise Club with Sandy Hook Promise.

The benefits of registering as an official SAVE Promise Club include:

- No-cost access to Sandy Hook Promise's [Know The Signs](#) violence prevention programs, including Say Something, Start With Hello, Signs of Suicide (SOS) and Safety Assessment & Intervention. Depending on your location and size of your school, a trained Sandy Hook Promise Presenter may be able to train your school in these programs at no-cost.
- Eligibility to have your students and club apply for special SAVE Promise Club awards and recognition.
- An invitation to join Sandy Hook Promise at our annual SAVE Promise Club Summit.
- Eligibility for club and students to apply to present at the annual SAVE Promise Club Summit.
- A certificate recognizing your school or youth organization as an official SAVE Promise Club.
- Recognition as an official SAVE Promise Club on the Sandy Hook Promise SAVE Promise Club website.
- Informative monthly newsletters and communications with tips, ideas and best practices for organizing SAVE Promise Club activities within your school or youth organization.
- Eligibility for your students to apply to join the SAVE Promise Club National Youth Advisory Committee.
- A chance to have your SAVE Promise Club featured in Sandy Hook Promise and SAVE Promise Clubs communications, social media and media events.
- Access to one-on-one support from Sandy Hook Promise.

Expectations of SAVE Promise Clubs:

- [Register](#) your SAVE Promise Club officially with Sandy Hook Promise.
- Bring Sandy Hook Promise's no-cost and easy to implement *Know The Signs* violence prevention programs to your school or youth organization. Sandy Hook Promise requires all SAVE Promise Clubs implement and sustain at least one of the *Know The Signs* programs: Say Something, Start With Hello and/or Signs of Suicide (SOS).
- Share your stories, successes, ideas and activities back to Sandy Hook Promise.
- Participate in at least one call to action per school year – either Say Something Week in October, or Start With Hello Week in February.
- Commit to creating an inclusive and welcoming SAVE Promise Club, dedicated to teaching and empowering your school or youth organization to prevent violence BEFORE it happens.
- Keep your SAVE Promise Club contact names and information current and up to date.
