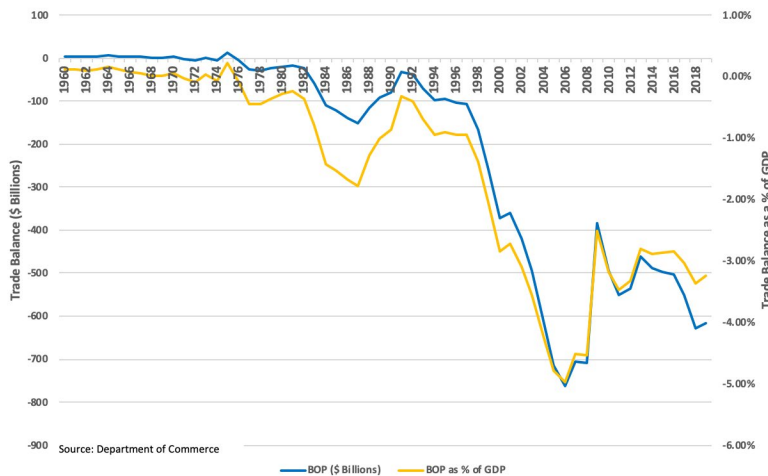

Trade Deficits Kill Jobs and Growth

There is no record of any other country in history that has run 44 years of consecutive trade deficits

Every billion dollars of net imports costs 6,000 American jobs. So last year's \$621 billion deficit equates to 3.7 million jobs lost

Net Exports Create

- Millions of jobs
- Sustainable economic growth
- Surges in tax revenue
- Increased manufacturing base

Free and Fair Trade Should:

Result in balanced trade. Past administrations trade has enabled mercantilism, imbalances and job destruction.

Our Manufacturing

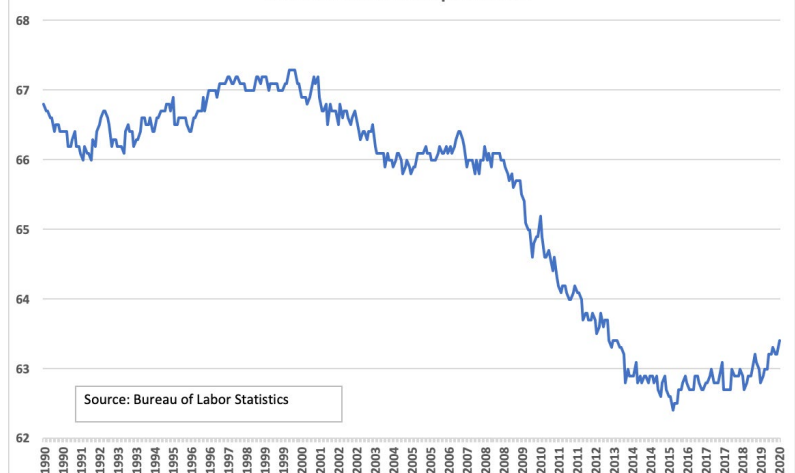
and Ag supply chains are the economic power! Jobs, innovation, value add, wealth creation, tax revenue.

Labor Force Participation Rate in Decline:

- The US is the only G7 nation with a DECLINE in LFPR since 1998 (Ages 15-64)
- Declined 3.9% in the last 20 years from 67% in 1998 to 63% in 2019
- Over 6 million people dropped out of labor force since 1998

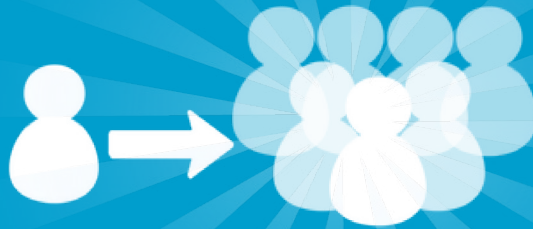

Manufacturing Job Losses since 2000

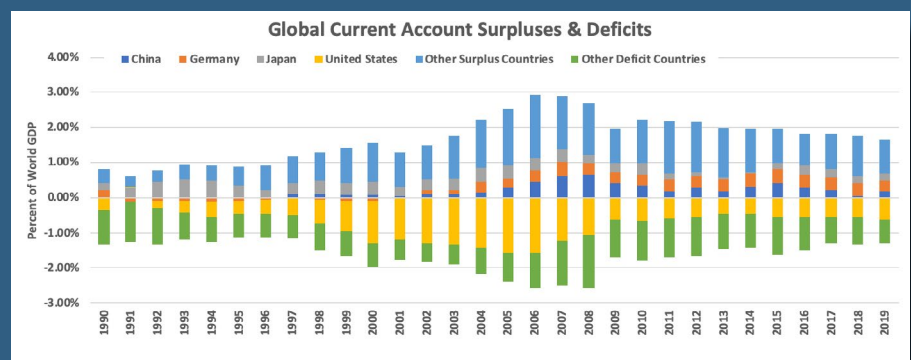
4.4M
