Rainbow Families Mission

We relieve poverty, distress and disadvantage of LGBTQ+ families by:

- Connecting, supporting and empowering LGBTQ+ families through peer support, community events, on-line support and playgroups;
- Developing and delivering education and resources including: parenting, making LGBTQ+ families, building resilience in children, and domestic violence; and
- Providing community education to reduce discrimination and promote inclusion of LGBTQ+ families.

Code of Conduct

Members of Rainbow Families agree to:

- Promote the mission of Rainbow Families;
- Show respect and courtesy towards others;
- Protect and care for children and young people;
- Act ethically, fairly, honestly, transparently and with integrity;
- Comply with any relevant legislative and administrative requirements including the ACNC and ATO requirements for charities;
- Be responsible for personal safety and seek to protect the safety of others; and
- Only represent Rainbow Families within your role (eg sub-committee member) or when authorised by the Board.
