Which animal eats what? Can you fill in the food web below using the following animals and plants?

Eucalyptus Tree: gets energy from the sun.

Fruit Tree: gets energy from the sun.

Grass: gets energy from the sun.

Possum: eats fruit, vegetables and flowers.

Kangaroo: eats mainly grasses and some shrubs.

Wombat: eats grasses, sedges, herbs, bark and roots.

Termite: eats dead plant material in the form of wood (trees).

Kookaburra: eats lizards, snakes, insects and mice.

Dingo: eats mainly rats, wallabies, rabbits, kangaroos, wallabies and possums.

Wedge-tail Eagle: eats rabbits, snakes, kangaroos, koalas and insects.

Cricket: eats decaying plant material such as eucalyptus trees.

Echidna: eats mainly termites.

Cockatoo: eats berries, seeds, nuts and fruits.

Tiger snake: eats lizards, frogs, small mammals, birds, insects and fish.

Crocodiles: eats fish, reptiles and mammals.

Koala: eats eucalyptus leaves.
