Unifor 594 Lock Out: Unifor 594 was locked out of their workplace at Coop Refinery in Regina. The lock out lasted for six months which featured blockades, arrests and even a bomb threat. The 730 Unifor workers were locked out of the CRC on Dec. 5, 2019, after they held a strike vote. The most contentious issue was proposed changes to employee pensions because of costs to the company.
