



# Clean Energy Jobs

It's time for Oregon to transition from polluting energy to a clean energy economy.

The Renew Oregon coalition is championing a policy to:

## Cap

Limits climate pollution from the **largest emitters** in the state. Small businesses like grocery stores, farms, ice cream shops, and florists will **not** fall under the cap, only those responsible for 25,000 metric tons of **greenhouse gases per year**, as much as burning 133 train cars full of coal. The cap comes down regularly over time to make certain emissions are reduced.

## Price

The largest emitters will pay for every ton of climate pollution they put into our air. This will lead them to adopt clean and energy-saving technologies, which saves money over time. Climate pollution emitters are **incentivized to cut emissions** with the **flexibility to do it at least cost**.

## Invest

Hundreds of millions of dollars per year will be **reinvested in Oregon clean energy solutions** to lower emissions and protect Oregonians against climate change. Guaranteed funds will be invested in **rural communities** for projects like wildfire prevention, drought protection and clean energy. **Equity** and a **just transition** to clean energy are central to the policy.

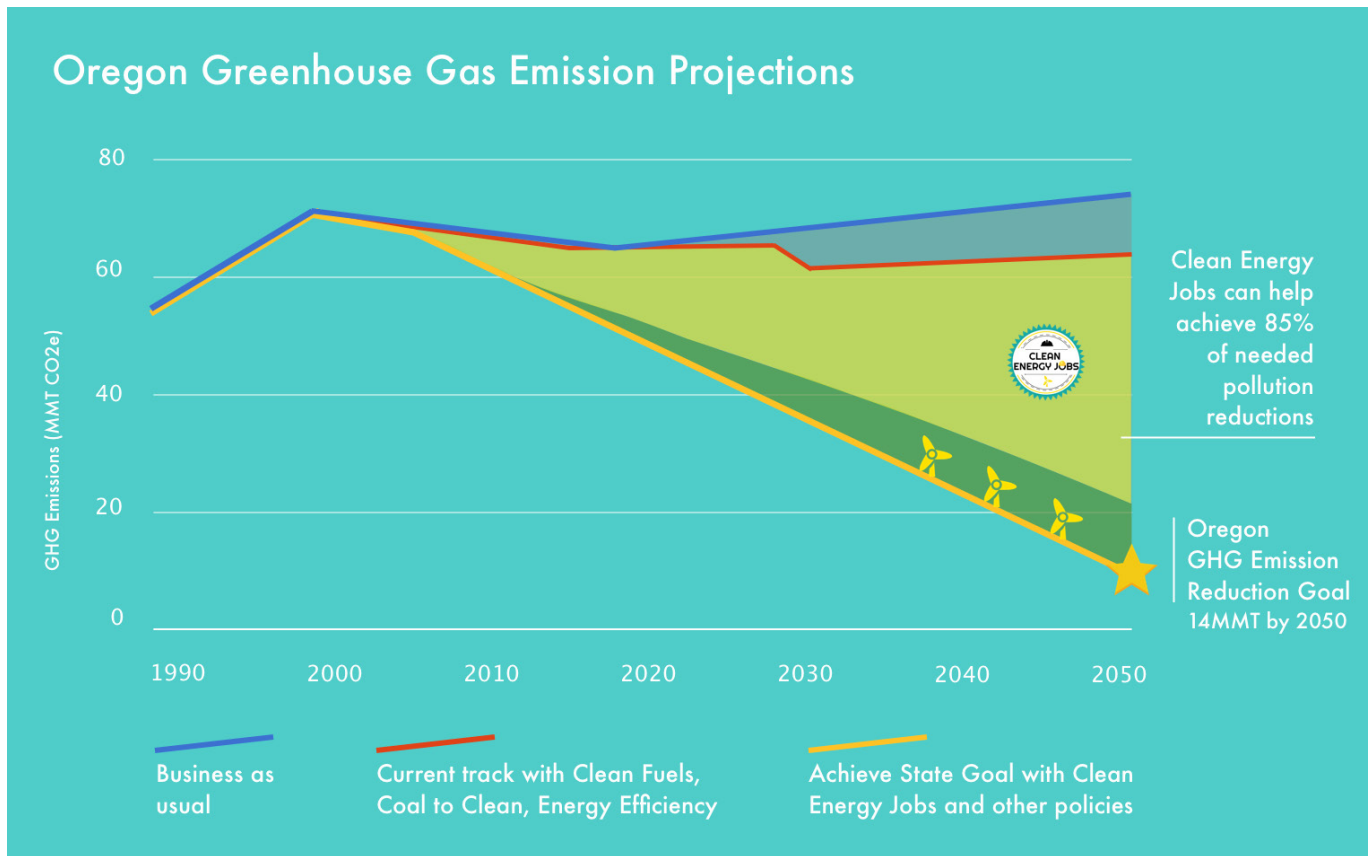
