Dear Mr. Hall,

My office has recently been contacted by constituents living near the Dominion Foundry site who are concerned that Quantum Murray workers are painting over the hoarding and plywood surrounding the Foundry buildings.

As I am sure you are aware the demolition of the historic Foundry buildings has been a contentious issue in the community. There have been a number of protests and considerable community organizing to save these buildings. Residents feel they have been denied an open, transparent consultation process, and are concerned that heritage protected buildings in their community are being destroyed. To raise awareness about this issue community members have created an art installation on the plywood on the south side of the site made up of posters and photos, and painted "Save the Foundry" on the hoarding on the north side of the site.

I am writing to request that your workers stop painting over the hoarding on the north side of the site, and ask that your workers do not paint over the art installations on the plywood on the south side of the Foundry site.

The community feels they have been denied the right to a fair planning process. This art installation is a type of peaceful protest and resistance. The posters and messages that have been posted as part of the art installation are not offensive and do not interfere with your work on the site.



I urge you to stop painting over the hoarding and plywood as an act of good faith to the community. This would help your company build goodwill and a more positive relationship with nearby residents.

Thank you for taking the time to review my letter. As this is an urgent matter, I hope you will take swift action to resolve this issue. Please do not hesitate to contact my office if you have any questions or concerns.
