Because we have an affordable housing crisis in our city, and because evictions are forecast to explode as a result of the pandemic, we are asking you to support an allocation of *at least* \$686,000 to the Eviction Diversion Program, and *at least* \$2.9 million to the Affordable Housing Trust Fund. We are also asking you to staff the Department of Housing and Community Development for purposes of administering the Affordable Housing Trust Fund.

- Allocate \$2.9 million to the Affordable Housing Trust Fund (as is currently being proposed). In addition - pass a resolution saying that as an additional .6 million becomes available in 2021, such funds will be allocated to the Affordable Housing Trust Fund (as was originally proposed).
- Allocate what was originally proposed for the Eviction Diversion Program (\$686,000)
- Staff the Department of Housing & Community Development – for purposes of administering the Affordable Housing Trust Fund.
