Reimbursement Policy for RNLA Conferences and Seminars

The Republican National Lawyers Association (RNLA) has established the Bob Horn Fund for Law Students in honor of its Founding Chair Robert J. Horn, to encourage law students to be more active in the RNLA. The Bob Horn Fund for Law Students will provide financial assistance to law students who wish to attend the RNLA's annual National Policy Conference (NPC) and National Election Law Seminar (NELS) and assist in the establishment of law student chapters in key states throughout the country.

RNLA staff will have sole discretion to disburse funds from the Bob Horn Fund for Law Students.

The RNLA has limited funds to assist law students with attending the NPC and NELS. To be eligible to receive these funds, students must:

- Be enrolled in law school or have graduated within the past year.
- Be an active member of the RNLA.
- Agree to volunteer to help ensure that elections are open, fair, and honest on Election Day or other days this year.
- Waive RNLA's liability for injuries sustained while traveling to or from or attending the NPC or NELS.

Preference will be given to students who:

- Are leaders in the RNLA or the Republican Party.
- Are involved in or working to start an RNLA law student chapter.

REGISTRATION

All recipients of the Bob Horn Fund are entitled to free registration for the NPC and NELS.

TRAVEL

All recipients of the Bob Horn Fund are entitled to a reimbursement of travel funds. Travel funds will be disbursed on a case-by-case basis, not to exceed \$300.

VOLUNTEERS

All recipients of the Bob Horn Fund who are also willing to volunteer for the NPC or the NELS will be eligible for lodging or a lodging reimbursement.

- NPC: All-day volunteers are entitled to an additional \$200 reimbursement for lodging.
- NELS: Volunteers for the two-day Seminar are entitled to two free rooms at the site of the Seminar.
