A3312: SEXUAL HARASSMENT TRAINING

Creates a safer work environment against discrimination and sexual harassment by significantly strengthening current policies



A2031: MENTAL HEALTH PARITY

Ensures there are no distinctions in the insurance, eligibility, or coverage for all branches of health—physical, mental, behavioral, or otherwise



A4463: ELECTRONIC BUILDING PERMITS

Brings the building permit process online to make life easier for homeowners and businesses



A4134: SECURE CHOICE RETIREMENT

Creates an IRA program to help employees and small businesses plan for a more secure retirement


