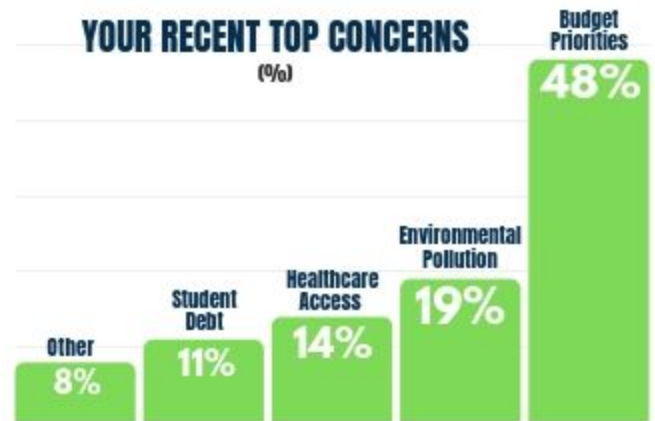
Legislation I'm working on to improve the lives of seniors and enhance their ability to live more easily in our great state includes:

- A4899 – Providing a tax exemption for contributions to retirement plans

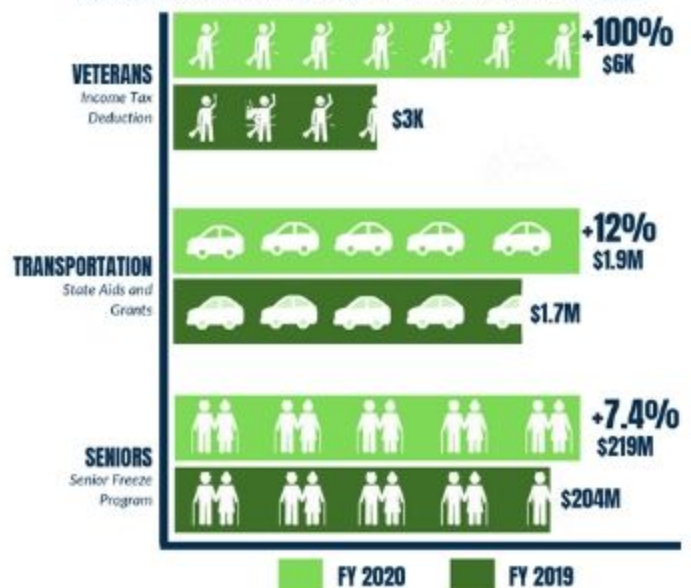
