

Public Policy Agenda Priorities:

The Network works diligently to improve the accessibility and affordability of quality child care options for all families. We support policies that address issues of equity in child care and urge our policy makers to:

- Protect and strengthen the child care delivery system so that every parent trying to provide for their family has the ability to do so, and every child care provider is adequately compensated for the care they deliver;
- Pass a budget that prioritizes quality, accessible child care for all children, especially infants and toddlers;
- Prioritize policies that help ensure all parents have the resources they need to care for their families.

April 28th -Last day for policy committees to hear and report fiscal bills for referral to fiscal Committees.

May 12th-Last day for *policy committees* to hear and report to the floor *non-fiscal* bills.

May 19th -Last day for *policy committees* to meet before June 5.

May 26th -Last day for fiscal committees to hear and report bills to the floor.

June 2nd - Last day to pass bills out of house of origin.

July 14th - Last day for policy committees to hear and report fiscal bills for referral to fiscal Committees.

July 21st- Last day for policy committees to hear and report bills.

Sept 1st- Last day for fiscal committees to hear and report bills to the floor.

Sept 8th- Last day to *amend* on the floor.

Sept 15th- Last day for any bill to be passed.

October 15th – Last day for Governor to sign or veto any bill passed by the Legislature on or before September 15th.
