

### **Public Policy Agenda Priorities:**

The Network works diligently to improve the accessibility and affordability of quality child care options for all families. We support policies that address issues of equity in child care and urge our policy makers to:

- Protect and strengthen the child care delivery system so that every parent trying to provide for their family has the ability to do so, and every child care provider is adequately compensated for the care they deliver;
- Pass a budget that prioritizes quality, accessible child care for all children, especially infants and toddlers;
- Prioritize policies that help ensure all parents have the resources they need to care for their families.

**April 28<sup>th</sup> -Last day for *policy committees* to hear and report fiscal bills for referral to fiscal Committees.**

**May 12<sup>th</sup> -Last day for *policy committees* to hear and report to the floor *non-fiscal* bills.**

**May 19<sup>th</sup> -Last day for *policy committees* to meet before June 5.**

**May 26<sup>th</sup> -Last day for *fiscal committees* to hear and report bills to the floor.**

**June 2<sup>nd</sup> - *Last day to pass bills* out of house of origin.**

**July 14<sup>th</sup> - Last day for *policy committees* to hear and report fiscal bills for referral to fiscal Committees.**

**July 21<sup>st</sup> - Last day for *policy committees* to hear and report bills.**

**Sept 1<sup>st</sup> - Last day for *fiscal committees* to hear and report bills to the floor.**

**Sept 8<sup>th</sup> - Last day to *amend* on the floor.**

**Sept 15<sup>th</sup> - Last day for any bill to be passed.**

**October 15<sup>th</sup> – Last day for Governor to sign or veto any bill passed by the Legislature on or before September 15<sup>th</sup>.**
