Re: Rancho Santa Fe system upgrades

Dear Property Owner:

In our ongoing efforts to provide safe and reliable energy to you, your neighbors and the businesses in your area, SDG&E® is modernizing the aging infrastructure associated with our current 4-kV system to a 12-kV system. We'll also upgrade the technology used to reduce extended outages. This is a courtesy notice to inform you about this project and to let you know that we're working with community members to keep disruptions to a minimum.

About the project

This project is divided into three phases and we're currently working on the second phase. A temporary construction staging yard, located on Calzada Del Bosque, will support the project and will be removed as soon as the entire project is completed. Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the first phase of the project is estimated to be completed by this summer, with overall completion of all three phases anticipated by March 2019. You can expect increased vehicle and foot activity during this time, while SDG&E and its contractors access the various power poles in the area.

Please be advised that certain poles aren't accessible by truck. In this case, these poles will be replaced by helicopter. To minimize flight paths, we've purposely located the staging yard as close to the project area as possible. For this current phase of the project, we anticipate no more than 7-10 days in which helicopter flights will occur, weather permitting. Helicopter activity will be consolidated rather than spread out over the course of the project to minimize disruption.

We understand that your neighborhood is home to many horses and facilities that house these animals, and we're working very closely with the Rancho Santa Fe Association staff to coordinate additional notifications. Our plans are to keep the helicopter work to a minimum as much as we can. We know you take good care of your animals – please let us know of any special concerns we should be aware of.

Work Hours

Work will be conducted between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., five days a week. This schedule is intended to minimize the potential for weekend outages and ensure that the project is completed as quickly as possible.
