PAID STOP WORK MEETING
WEDNESDAY 14TH SEPTEMBER FOR ALL RTBU MEMBERS

You deserve to hear the facts from all parties around the Adelaide Metro negotiating table.

Now we are getting close to reaching an in-principle agreement with the South Australian Government.

So far we have achieved in-principle agreement on important issues such as:

- Guarantee pay rise of at least 2.5% per year – plus any Work Value & productivity-related increase;
- Back pay guaranteed until from 1 January 2014;
- Clarity around special leave – including cultural leave, domestic violence leave, trauma leave & bereavement leave;
- Roster principles to be incorporated into the agreement, plus a comprehensive review;
- National Rail Qualifications for all members;
- Shift harmonisation; and
- APM calculation into the agreement.

But there is more work to do before we can seal the deal.

All RTBU members – regardless of who their bargaining agent is – are invited to a paid stop work meeting to discuss the details of negotiations and to agree on a way forward.
