PLEASE NOTE:

1. Emails to the AEC inbox that appear to be spam may be blocked. It is the responsibility of senders to ensure that their email reaches the AEC before the deadline for nominations.
2. In order to be able to be received by the AEC, emails (including attachments) should be no greater than 6 MB in size.

Withdrawing Nominations - Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 12:00pm Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on 27/03/2020.

Voting Period - The Attendance ballot, if required, will open at 7:00am Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) and close at 4:30pm Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on 08/04/2020.

Scrutineers - The appointment of scrutineers opens 25/02/2020 and closes 9:00am Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on 09/04/2020. A form is available from the Returning Officer for the purposes of appointing Scrutineers.
