You may feel comfortable being a witness in one or more of these ways:

1. Pray silently or with a group
2. Hold a compassionate sign
3. Hand out literature to the women going in
4. Or just be there!

All of your actions as a vigil participant must be peaceful and reflect God's love for all people. Here are some guidelines:

- Show compassion to all abortion facility employees and customers; do not threaten, physically contact, or verbally abuse
- Remain on public property (sidewalk); do not stand on facility property or obstruct the driveway or sidewalks
- Bring at least one other person with you
- Come with a compassionate attitude (we must love the woman and her family and friends)
- Get the woman's attention by saying something like, "Excuse me, can I give you some information?"
- Let the woman know there is help for her if she would choose to make a different decision, and provide her with contact information for a local pregnancy care center.
- There may be "escorts" who will walk up with the women to the door. They will talk to the woman to prevent her from listening to you. You may still try to get her attention and try to give her a brochure. Please pray for these escorts.
