



Organizer, part time

Parents 4 Teachers (P4T), a non-profit education advocacy organization, seeks a part-time organizer. This position will help grow P4T's grassroots parent support network and recruit parents to work on projects and campaigns.

P4T was founded on the belief that the needs of teachers go hand in hand with the needs of students. P4T's mission is to stand up for teachers and fight for quality schools for ALL Chicago children. Because teachers' working conditions are children's learning conditions, we believe that building solidarity among parents and teachers is key. We also believe that supporting social justice teacher unionism and fighting racist school policies is necessary to build a high quality, equitable and just public school system for all of Chicago.

Responsibilities include:

- Assist in developing and implementing organizing strategies and campaign plans.
- Identify, recruit, and develop relationships with parents to participate in P4T's work.
- Help identify and recruit members to serve on P4T leadership team and board.
- Attend and testify, as needed, at public hearings, CPS Board of Education meetings, and other public events.
- Help prepare outreach materials and social media posts.
- Work with P4T allies in education justice movement.

Qualifications:

- Strong commitment to education justice and the labor movement.
- Strong written and oral communication skills. Must be comfortable speaking in public.
- Demonstrated ability to motivate others.
- Ability to solve problems creatively and manage multiple tasks and responsibilities.
- Willingness to work after school, evenings and some weekends.
- Experience in community/ grassroots organizing/education preferable but not required.
- Spanish language fluency a plus.
