Preparations underway for the bushfire season

As the bushfire danger season begins, suburbs on the outskirts of Adelaide including Blackwood, Belair, Brownhill Creek and Eden Hills are being urged to be 'bushfire ready'.

The State Liberal Government has organised prescribed burns on private and public land including in Belair National Park.

Strategic burns help lessen the threat of bushfires throughout the height of the summer season.

Member for Waite, Sam Duluk MP, whose electorate covers bushfire prone areas is encouraging local residents to be prepared and stresses the importance of having a bushfire action plan organised.
