

**WHAT:** Road Resurfacing & Sidewalk/Curb Replacement, Repair & Maintenance Work  
**WHEN:** September 3rd, 2019  
**WHERE:** Acadia Drive from McKercher Drive to 14<sup>th</sup> Street East

**Due to unforeseen circumstances, the phasing for this project has changed. We apologize for this inconvenience and request that you review the updated phasing information below.**

The City of Saskatoon (City) will be completing road resurfacing work in your neighbourhood beginning on **September 3rd**. The work will take approximately **6 days** to complete, weather permitting and barring unforeseen circumstances. **Prairie Paving Inc.** has been contracted to complete this project.

## During this project

- The work will be completed in phases and is scheduled as follows, weather permitting:
  - Phase 1: Sidewalk/curb** replacement, repair and maintenance work is now complete.
  - Phase 2:** Road resurfacing work is anticipated to take place on **Acadia Drive** starting **September 3, 2019**. The road will be resurfaced using new hot mix asphalt. The work will be broken into phased sections as follows:
    - Phase 2A:** (Sept. 3) From 14<sup>th</sup> Street East to north of McGill Street (includes 14<sup>th</sup> Street East intersection);
    - Phase 2B:** (Sept. 4 – 5) From north of McGill Street to ½ Acadia Place intersection;
    - Phase 2C:** (Sept. 6) From ½ Acadia Place intersection to the back-lane between Dalhousie Crescent/Simon Fraser Crescent;
    - Phase 2D:** (Sept. 7) From the back-lane between Dalhousie Crescent/Simon Fraser Cres.to Acadia Court (east entrance);
    - Phase 2E:** (Sept. 8) From Acadia Court (East entrance) to McKercher Drive;
- Once work begins, heavy equipment will be required to complete this work. Some noise and vibration is anticipated.

## How you can help

- Stay clear of the work zone for your safety and the safety of workers.
- Avoid watering your lawn for **two (2) days prior** to the date indicated above. Water and wet surfaces will delay this work.

## Common questions



### Will black, blue or green cart collection be affected as a result of this work?

Residents directly adjacent to the work are required to leave their carts outside of the work area prior to 7 am on the day of collection. The contractor will coordinate the pickup of your cart.



### Will there be traffic and street/driveway access restrictions?

There will be traffic and street/driveway access restrictions adjacent to the work area during the work. Signs will be posted and traffic will be detoured as required during the work on the road.



### Will parking be affected?

For households/businesses directly adjacent to the work in progress, access to driveways and street parking will be restricted. For residents with mobility requirements please contact us.



### Will water and sewer service be affected?

Water and sewer service will not be affected by this work.



### Will bus routes change?

Bus routes within the construction area may be affected. Please use the mobile app called 'Transit' for real-time service alerts.
