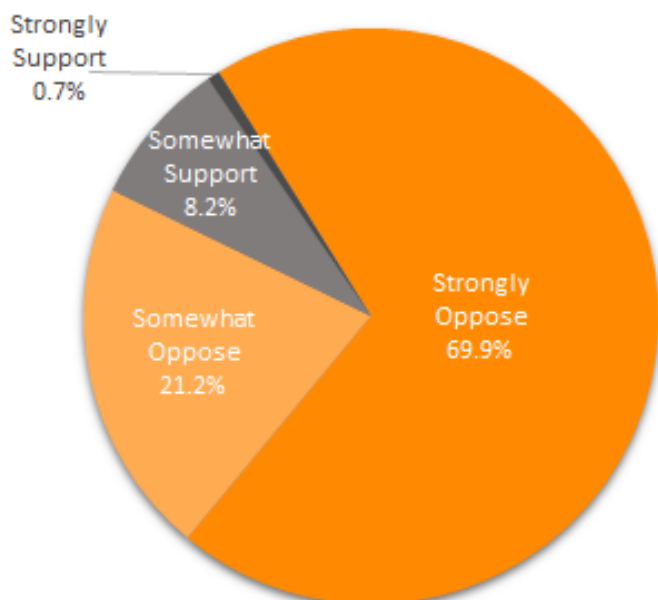
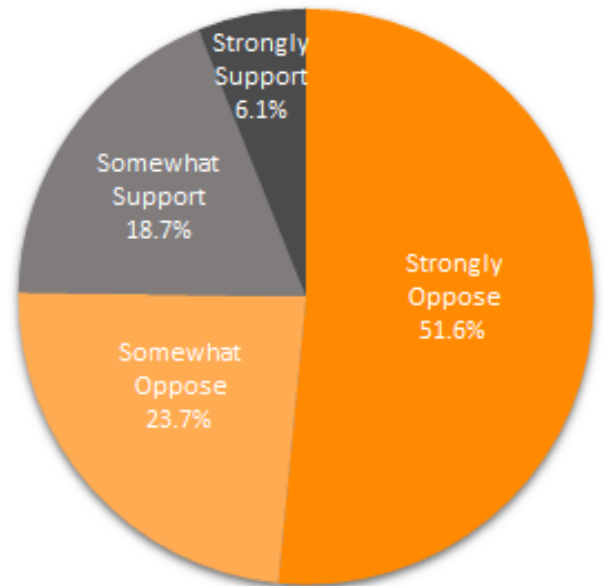

Reducing funding to classrooms from kindergarten through post-secondary.

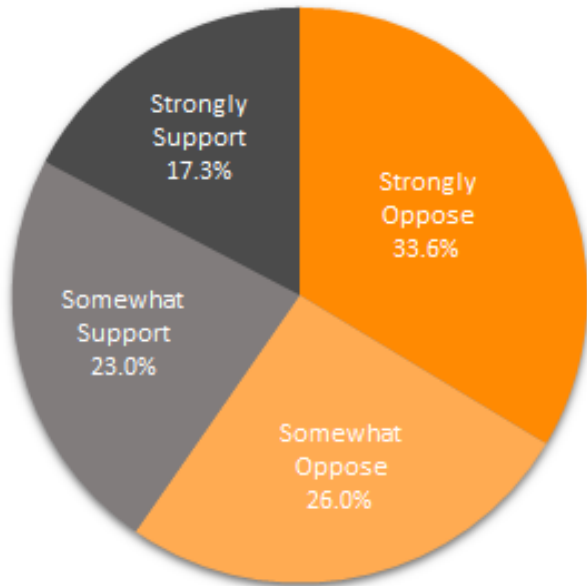

Total Opposed: 59.7%

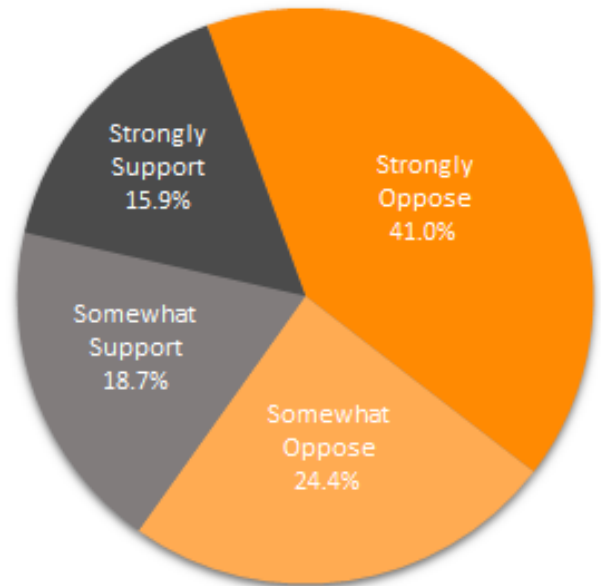

Total Opposed: 65.4%

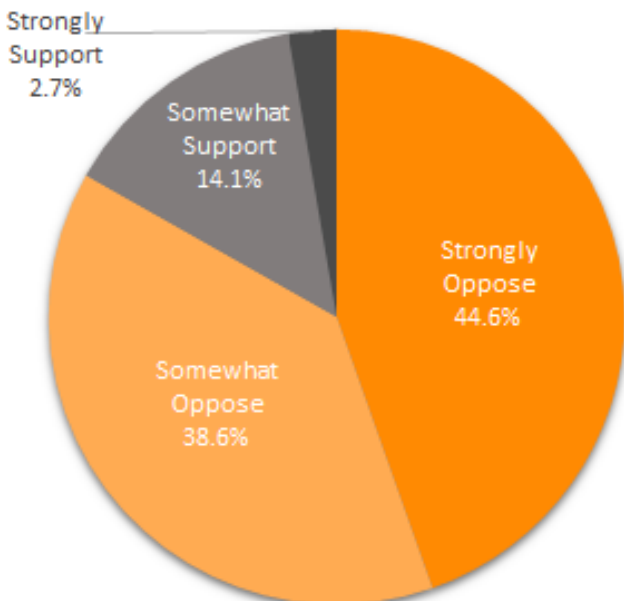

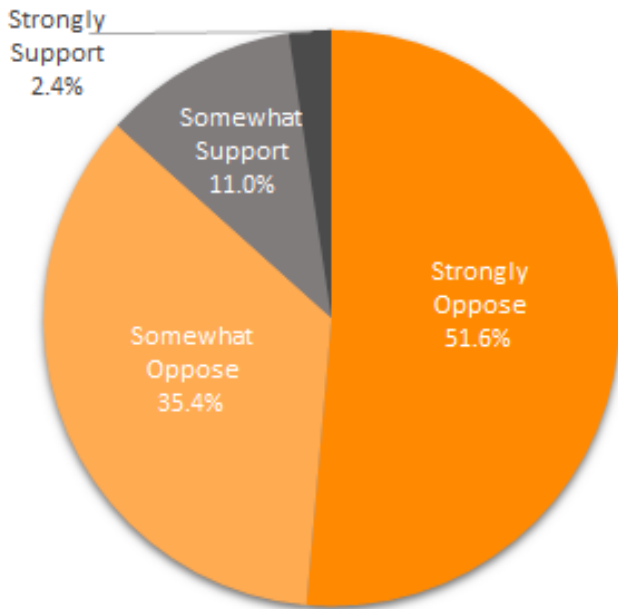

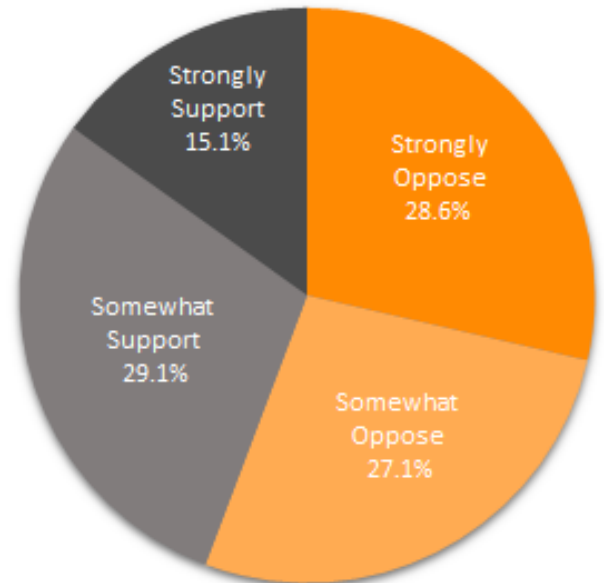

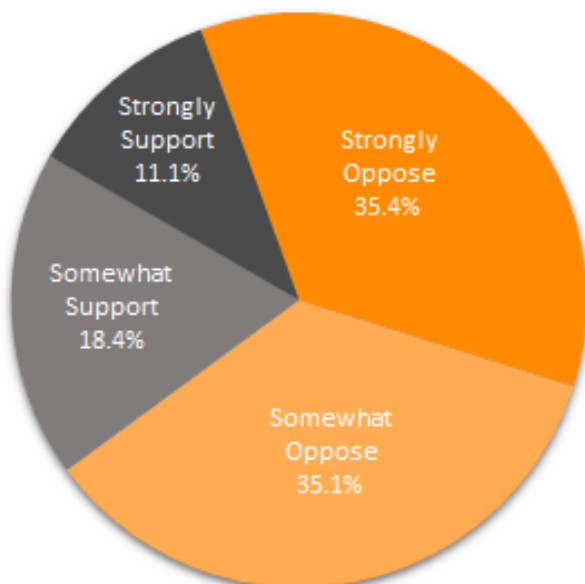

Eliminating funding for funeral service for social assistance recipients.

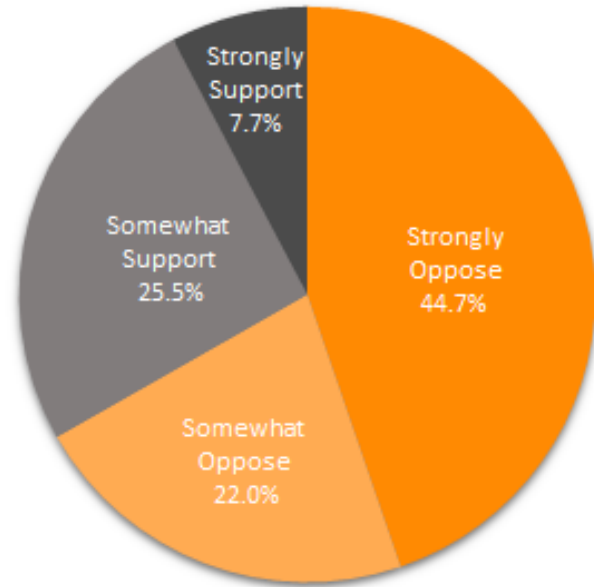

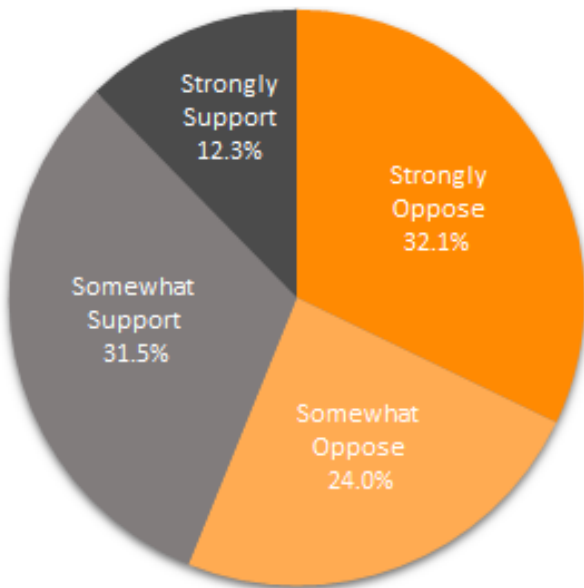
Expanding the Provincial Sales Tax to start charging it on children's clothes.

Total Support: 33.3%



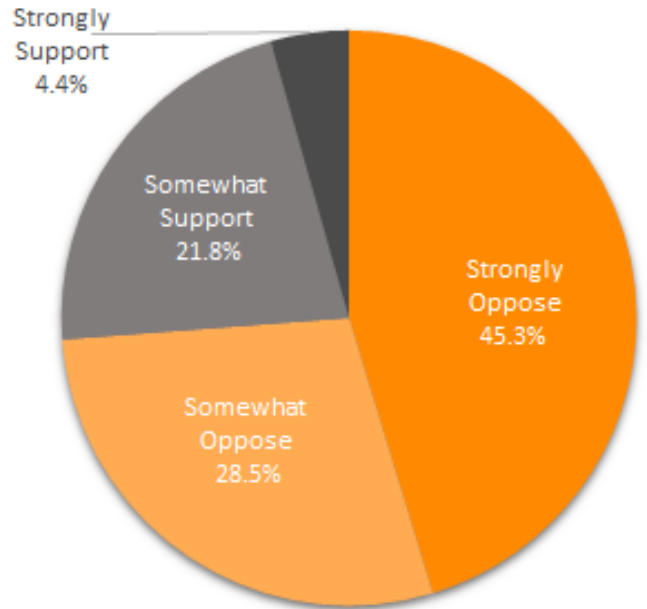
Expanding the Provincial Sales Tax to start charging it on restaurant meals.

Total Support: 43.8%



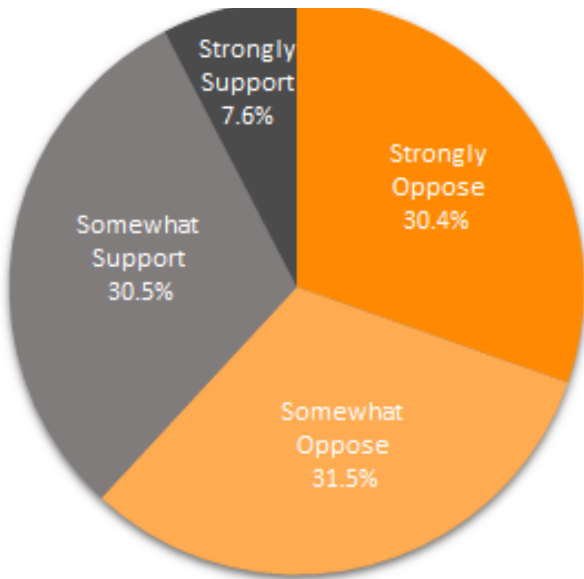
Expanding the provincial sales tax to start charging it on insurance premium payments.
