


WA Gender Pay Gap Report 2020

In February 2020 the Australian Bureau of Statistics released survey data for November 2019 that provides the basis for analysis of the gender pay gap in Australia as well as at a state level including Western Australia¹. The gender pay gap compares the full-time ordinary earnings of men and women, expressed as a percentage (Chart 1).




The gender pay gap in WA is the largest in Australia.


Comparing full time ordinary earnings, women in WA are paid \$412 per week less than men on average.


Over the past three years, the national gender pay gap has improved slightly each year: contracting from 15.3% in 2017 to 13.9% in 2019 while there has been no improvement in WA (Chart 2).



Both male and female earnings are growing far more strongly nationally than they are in WA (Chart 3).



Compared with the Federal Government and other State and Territory governments, the WA Government employs the highest percentage of women (Chart 4).




In WA, one in three women are employed in the public sector.

There are 628,000 women employed in WA of which 189,000 work in the public sector. Of those workers, 55% work in the WA state public sector, the remainder in local or federal government employment.²



Diagram 1: WA Public sector, women and men employed (%)³




The pay gap in the private sector is far worse than in the public sector, however, only the private sector has been showing improvements over recent years (Chart 5).

Over the past three years, among men and women employed in the private and public sectors, women in the public sector have gone from the highest to the lowest earnings growth.
