

Central's Indicative fees for 2015

1. These fees are estimates for students doing State subsidized courses on a full time basis starting in 2015.
2. Additional materials, equipment and/or other costs may apply.
3. The indicative fees for a course may differ between training providers due to the units they have included in the course outline. These differences generally result from adapting courses to meet local industry needs.
4. The cost and duration of your course will depend on your individual circumstances. Actual fees will be advised at enrolment and will depend on the electives you choose.
5. Nominal hours are not hours of training or instruction. They are used to determine course fees and subsidy levels to reflect the cost to deliver quality training.
6. Fees quoted are applicable for the portion of training undertaken in 2015. Where fees are quoted for courses that take more than one year to complete (three or more semesters/six month periods), the relevant fees for 2016 and 2017 will apply for that portion of the course and fees will be adjusted accordingly in subsequent years.

Concession and Caps

7. A Concession Rate is available for students enrolled in a State subsidized Certificate I, II, III and IV courses only. Students with a valid Concession Card, pay 50% of the tuition fees. No concession is given for Resource fees or foundation skills or equity courses. Concessions fees will be confirmed prior to enrolment.
8. For students born after 1 July 1997 (who are at least 15 years old and who undertake training that is not part of a VET in Schools program) who enrol in a State subsidized course there will be a cap of \$410 per year for 2015. Resource fees are not included in the annual cap. The cap applies irrespective of the number of courses a student is enrolled in.
9. Course fees for State subsidized diploma and advanced diploma will not exceed \$7,700 per course, per year in 2015. Resource fees are not included in the annual cap.

Caps apply to Priority Industry Qualifications, General Industry Training, apprenticeships and traineeships and Foundation Skills courses, and to concessional and non-concessional students. These caps do not include fees for Recognition of Prior Learning or commercial courses (fee for service).

VET FEE-HELP

10. VET FEE-HELP student loans for the total fee (i.e. course fee and resource fee) are available for eligible students in diploma and advanced diplomas and the Certificate IV trial qualifications. The 20% loan fee does not apply to students doing State subsidized courses.

Please note:

- A student's guarantee to a place in a government funded state priority course is subject to course availability.
