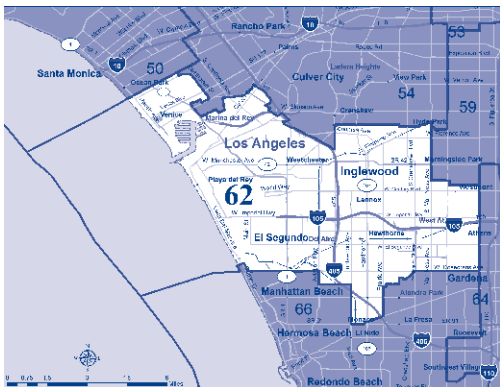

LEGISLATIVE INTERESTS: Affordable College, Good Public Schools, Job-Training, Safe Neighborhoods.

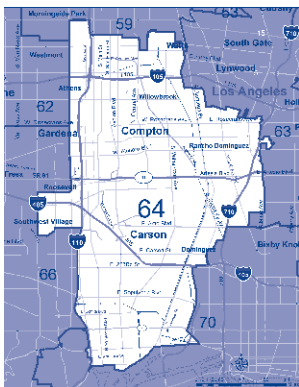
