Roles and Responsibilities

Hours of work: in line with programme of activities

Overall Job Purpose: to drive participants, staff and volunteers of SHINE to different activities and venues

Reporting to: Coordinator

To become a bus driver for SHINE, you must

- Have a valid mini bus licence (D1 or B or equivalent)
- Experience and valid training in driving a wheelchair accessible vehicle
- Experience and valid training in clamping wheelchairs onto bus
- Have a positive and enthusiastic attitude
- Willing to assist with programme activities where required
- Be a caring, hard working, responsible and compassionate person

To become a SHINE Bus Driver you must:

- **Be 21 years of age, or older, by the 21st June prior to SHINE starting**
- **Have a full and clean drivers licence**
- **Have a Driver Certificate of Professional Competence (CPC)**
- **Be an excellent communicator**
- **Have a positive and enthusiastic attitude**
- **Be a caring, hard working, responsible and patient person**
