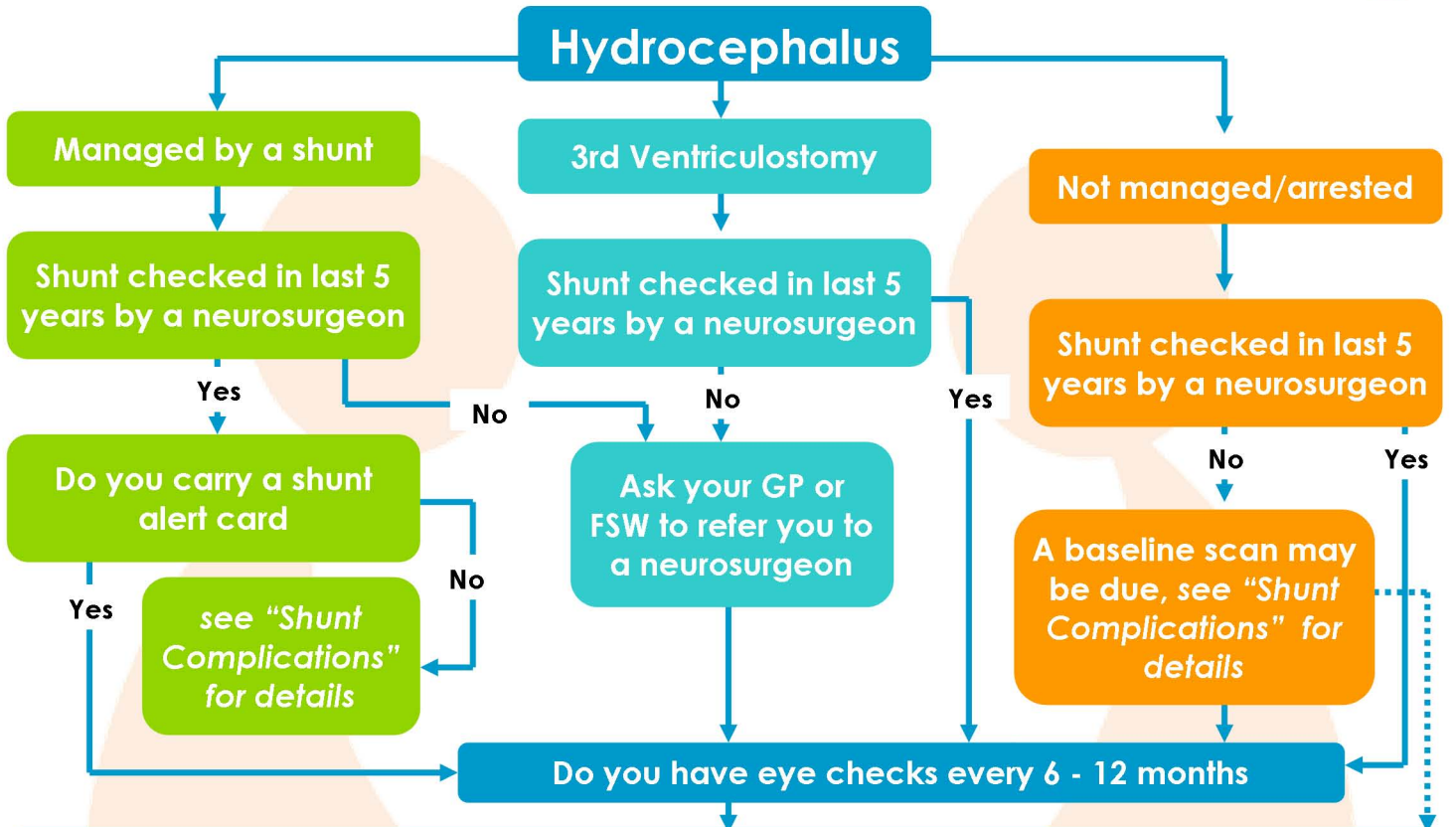




Shunt Management Chart
