Nomination Process: Applicants may self-nominate. Any person other than a corporation or society may stand for election by submitting an application form to be approved by the SCIC membership at the AGM. Term: Each director is elected to hold office for two years. At each AGM, those who have completed a two-year term are eligible for re-election to a maximum of 5 consecutive terms.

Time Commitment: The full board meets quarterly. There are additional opportunities for committee involvement, strategic visioning and event participation throughout the year. The Board has established the following standing committees: Executive; Finance, Audit & Fundraising; Membership & Awards; Governance & Policy Committee; and Personnel (HR). Required time commitment varies, depending on a director's role, availability, and interest.
