The Donald MacLeod Award for Exceptional Team Work sponsored by the [Scotrail Alliance](#)

The Exceptional Team Work Award has been named in memory of former Support Worker, Donald MacLeod, who held team work in the highest of importance for all young people he worked with.

This award recognises a Constituency, Local Authority area, National Voluntary Organisation, Subject Committee, or other (formal or informal) group of MSYPs that have worked as team to further the aims of SYP and represent Scotland's Young People over the past year.

Any group of current MSYPs* (as outlined above) can be nominated for this award.

*The Board of Trustees and Conveners Group are exempt from this category as exceptional team work is expected as a standard for these roles.

The Donald MacLeod Award for Exceptional Team Work - Nomination criteria:

- What has the team group done to benefit the work of the Scottish Youth Parliament and young people in Scotland?
- How has the group gone above and beyond what is expected?
- How have the group worked together as a team to overcome obstacles and reach their goals?
