



Resolution to validate the integrity of the Spokane County voting system
Spokane County Republican Party Executive Board
February 2, 2021

Whereas, we are a party committed to the rule of law and the integrity and validity of fair elections, and are opposed to any actions or individuals that risk undermining these; and

Whereas, we support the need to accurately count and verify all legal votes; and

Whereas, there is compelling evidence of a pattern of significant election statute violations, voting irregularities, and electronic tabulating irregularities attested to by credible election observers, election employees and volunteers who provided sworn affidavits and testimony in state house and senate hearings in other states during the most recent national election; and

Whereas, Washington State has been identified in the national media as the testing ground for the type of voting issues and disputes that recently occurred at the national level which created uncertainty in the integrity and validity of the voting process, and eroded voter confidence; and

Whereas, voter confidence in the election process appears to have hit an all-time low risking voter interest and participation in the electoral process; and

Whereas, there have been ongoing concerns about election integrity and validity for years without an organized effort to conduct Forensic Audits to substantiate and rectify current and past concerns; and

Whereas, Washington State Secretary of State, Kim Wyman (R), has encouraged local counties to verify the integrity of voting systems and processes.

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the Spokane County Republican Central Committee Executive Board "SCRCC", will allocate time and resources to co-ordinate with the Washington State Republican Party "WSRP", and others, to conduct a Forensic Audit of Spokane County Elections Office procedures and processes to discover any irregularities and statutory deviations that may exist with the voting system, including processes that could risk voting integrity and validity and undermine voter confidence.

Be it further resolved that the SCRCC Executive Board is committed to the integrity and validity of fair elections so that all citizens can have confidence in our government and that their vote was tabulated correctly, as we continue to fight to uphold laws and policies that benefit all America.
