



Important Convention Notice from the SCRCC Board:

Due to the current State / National Emergency declarations, crowd restrictions, and other efforts to protect the public from the Coronavirus, we cannot hold a complete convention where all the delegates can discuss platform changes and other business. We are investigating options for a modified convention and State Convention delegate selection process. We have been in consultation with the State Party and are currently looking at how to stay within the rules, protect the public, and be good citizens by helping curtail the current virus threat.

We met in an emergency session last night to address the situation. The first option we are pursuing is to put together a system of online voting for the delegates to ensure we complete our selection of delegates to the State Convention before the April 11 deadline. There are several issues dealing with credentialing and secrecy of ballots that will need to be addressed. The State is working with counties and certain vendors to resolve these issues. We will communicate more details as they become available. The time for this voting may change from the currently scheduled date of March 21, 2020.

In order to follow the guidelines that the caucus and delegate voting process be self-financing, there will still be a registration fee. But it will be less than published fees. As a result of these fee changes we will not have the opportunity to build our funds for the important elections this fall. Those who have already registered may still donate those funds to the party.

We will be working through the weekend and the first days of next week to put the details together. Please watch for further information in your email. Thank you for your understanding during this time.
