

Meeting Notes

April 24, 2018

These notes are a supplement to the regular Site Representative Council meeting. You should share these things at your monthly 10 minute meeting. It should not be used as a replacement for attending meetings.

Items to share at your 10 minute meeting:

- 1. June Election** – Please encourage members to vote in June. The CTA endorsed candidate for Superintendent of Public Instruction is Tony Thurmond. If members vote in June in large enough numbers, Thurmond could win the election. Election commitment cards should be filled in. Remind your members that if they complete the form, they won't get campaign calls from CTA.
- 2. San Diego County Board of Education** – Encourage members to vote for Rich Shea in North County and Alicia Munoz in East County for the San Diego County School Board. Both are incumbents.
- 3. Benefits** - You can ask the Benefits committee member, James Love or Kim Edmunds, to come to your site and give a presentation and answer questions about different services. A new wellness center will be opening in Mission Valley for VEBA. There will be different types of classes. VEBA can set up site-based classes also. Contact Kim Edmunds or James Love for more information.
- 4. Benefits** - STRS will bring workshops to our district. Please check with members if they would like to attend workshops on retirement benefits and let Kim or James know how many members are interested.
- 5. Bargaining** – **An update will be sent out Wednesday, April 25, 2018 after our bargaining session.**
- 6. SEA Scholarships** – Member dependents can apply for college scholarships. Information is posted on the seacta.org website under Member Resources. Due date for applications is May 4, 2018.
- 7. Board of Directors Election** – The offices of Secretary, Treasurer, and At-Large Seat A are up for election. Declaration of Candidacy forms should be in mailboxes by Thursday, April 26th. The Candidacy forms and Election Timeline are posted on the seacta.org website under Member Resources. Candidacy forms are due to the Association office by 5:00 Wednesday, May 9th, 2018.
