

## Vice President's Report

**Organizing** - During April I have been working with Organizing concerning the "Cookies with Carrie" presentation held on April 9<sup>th</sup>.

**Communications** - I have been setting up the new seacta.org email addresses and will work with Communications to look into reworking the seacta.org website.

**Bargaining** – I met with the Stipend committee to lend support to this very hard-working committee. We will get this article done this year!!

**District meeting** - On Monday, April 15<sup>th</sup>, a meeting was held with the District at the SCTU office from 10:30 am to 1:00 pm. Present at the meeting were the Presidents and Lead Negotiators from SEA and SCGA. Also present was Lian Shoemake CTA staff. The District team include Karen Janney, Scott Hendries, Jennifer Carbuccia, and Thomas Glover. The District asked for the meeting to present information concerning the Budget and information regarding other financial information.

6. Management Furlough Days for the 2019-2020 school year.

This was not a bargaining session, but the focus of the discussion was that 2 furlough days would save approximately 4.5 million dollars. It was clarified during the meeting by Lian Shoemake, CTA staff, that this **was not** a bargaining session and that we would need to include the Bargaining Team and membership

The district asked to set up a bargaining session to negotiate the calendar. **The SEA bargaining team is set to meet with the District on Thursday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>.**

An MOU was also drafted and signed by Gene and I concerning a Honorarium for the NIMSS Summer Training. The District is no longer able to pay Curriculum rate for the 4-day training for Middle and High School

Math, Science, and English teachers. NIMSS will be providing an honorarium of \$500 for any District Math, Science or English teacher to attend all four days.
