

VICTORY! SEIU Members Win 6 Weeks Paid Family Leave Benefit!

SEIU union members have led the fight for Paid Family Leave (PFL)!

On June 23, the Fairfax Board of Supervisors listened and voted to create 6 weeks of PFL for Fairfax County merit employees, effective October 10, 2020.

PFL is a NEW *paid* benefit, which can be used in addition to your current sick leave, pandemic leave, etc. It replaces the 2 weeks of parental leave currently available.

PFL can be used:

- For the birth or adoption of a child;
- When you are unable to work due to a serious health condition, chronic condition or ongoing medical treatment;
- When you need to care for a family member who has a serious health condition, chronic condition or ongoing medical treatment, such as serious surgery, cancer treatment, diabetes, and more.

Thanks to the advocacy of SEIU members like you, PFL will cover workers with pre-existing conditions, and we won't have to wait until 2021 for it to start!
