## #Done Waiting

**Without a contract, recruitment is nearly impossible and understaffing just keeps getting worse.**

The government either doesn't understand or doesn't care that SEIU-West health care workers deserve a wage increase and that conditions in Saskatchewan long-term care homes, hospitals, and home care must be improved.
