Communities Restoration

- Evaluate employment policies and compose legislation that eliminates practices that are exclusionary to persons of color, mentally ill or homeless.
- We need to eradicate the pipeline to prison that traps so many black and brown citizens.
- We need to improve educational resources and programs in low income communities to close the achievement gap.

Job and Career Access

In the past 2 years, I have communities of color are being told by multiple SF businesses that they not a "cultural fit" or otherwise excluded from job opportunities. This is only one of several barriers to accessing work and job opportunities for people of color, women, mentally ill and seniors. There is exclusion based on education, past incarceration or non-narcotic drug usage

are other practices that exclude large populations from getting work. We need a Democratic Party to resolve to remove these barriers.

Social Services

There are major gaps in the services that are organized to prevent our people from becoming homeless. There are also gaps in the services that are organized to support our people on the path out of these homelessness. I know from firsthand experience that these services are woefully insufficient to get the job done. What is available is insufficient to meet the current demands. Our resources are failing to bring many out of poverty. A I am interested in working on a legislative agenda that provides more publicly accessible services such as restrooms, showers, laundry, health and human services.

3) What are your plans to encourage and empower the Latino Community into the Democratic political process?

My goals are to persuade members Latino/a and Black communities to join the Latino Democratic and Latino/a Young Democrats of San Francisco as well as the Chicano Democratic Caucus as well as to attend important Brown and Black cultural events, forums.

I will also participate in connecting our Latino/a and Black people to resources and opportunities to participate, learn and take leadership in the course of our communities and the future of our city.
