




Hogan Road to McCaslin Lake Road

Paddling Skill: Intermediate to Beginner

River Character: Rural Residential to Woodland Wetland

Distance: 5.29 river miles

The Shiawassee River Water Trail is 88 miles long, from Holly to Chesaning, MI.

Trip Expectations

This trip begins near the Hogan Road Wastewater Treatment Plant. There is a worn footpath from the road to the river. Parking is available along Hogan Road.

The rural residential section shoreline is somewhat developed with housing on both sides of the river with private boating docks.

After 2 miles the river character becomes **Woodland Wetland** where paddlers encounter natural features such as: wetlands, marshes, oxbows and wildlife. There will be low visibility and some natural obstructions that require paddling around.

Exit the river at McCaslin Lake Road, on the left bank you will see a gravel approach to the river. There is a dirt parking lot at the top of the hill. Food, shopping, and gas are available in Argentine Township just east on Silver Lake Road.

Paddling Skill: Intermediate to Beginner

Due to the length of this trip, it is advised that paddlers have some experience. This stretch can become dangerous during periods of heavy rain and flooding. In the early summer it is most likely suitable for beginners who might prefer to exit the river at Cole Road.

Trees are cleared for ease of paddling, but there still may be hazards to navigate.

Car Shuttle Route

Go south on Hogan road. Make a right onto Silver Lake road. Take it all the way to McCaslin Lake road and make a right and head north. There is little parking at this location near the boat launch.

Paddling Safety and Manners

- Be respectful of private property and only stop at designated landing and launch locations.
- Remember to share, care, and enjoy the river! Be neighborly, keep music and voices at a low volume, and dispose of all litter properly.
- Plan your trip and let others know your plans and when you expect to return.
- Always wear a US Coastguard approved life vest while paddling, and only paddle where it's suitable to your abilities. You must have a white light on the front of your boat when paddling during low light or night.


