The City is of the opinion that we can provide more comprehensive information about the potential impacts on heritage, which is a Matter of Provincial Importance, as well as more fully describe our strategy for managing and mitigating these impacts.

Under subsection 10(1) of Ontario Regulation 231/08, if a notice of issue is given, the 120-day TPAP consultation period stops running and will resume when the above-noted issue has been addressed and a notice of resumption has been provided to you.
