



WHAT IS MY SCHOOL DC?

My School DC is the District’s common application and public school lottery for DC Public Schools (DCPS) and the majority of public charter schools (PK3—grade 12). Families can now apply to schools using one application and participate in a single, random lottery. The My School DC application is an online-only application accessible at MySchoolDC.org.

WHO NEEDS TO APPLY?

Submit a My School DC lottery application if your child will be a **NEW** student at a:

- Participating public charter school (grades PK3-12)
- DCPS school outside your boundary or feeder pattern for any grade (PK3-12), including DCPS citywide schools
- PK3 or PK4 program at any DCPS school, including your in-boundary school
- DCPS selective high school or program (grades 9-12)

SCHOOL YEAR 2019-20 LOTTERY KEY DATES

February 1, 2019:	Application deadline (grades 9-12)
March 1, 2019:	Application deadline (grades PK3-8)
March 29, 2019:	Lottery results are available
May 1, 2019:	Enrollment deadline for matched students
