57	code and District ward;
58	(3) A unique identifier for the grant and of the parent entity of the recipient
59	entity, should the entity be owned by another entity;
60	(4) The amount of the grant;
61	(5) Awarding agency;
62	(6) Grant title;
63	(7) Narrative descriptive of the purpose of the Grant;

- (c) The website shall include all relevant data for fiscal year 2015 and each fiscal year thereafter. Grants shall be added no more than 30 days after they are awarded by an agency.
- (d) The website shall be designed so that it may be easily expanded to include additional datasets related to government spending, such as contract awards or tax subsidies.
- (e) Nothing in this act shall prohibit the Chief Financial Officer from including on the website information or data that is publically available from any other public or private database.
