2. Track 2: GED or other occupational training – Project Empowerment

The agency has recently begun collecting occupational skills training data for Project Empowerment. Before now, occupational skills training occurred less frequently compared to other programs that it wasn't statistically significant enough to isolate.

B. DC Career Connections

2. Track 1: subsidized employment – DC Career Connections

Narrative: DC Career Connections (DCCC) is aligned with agency goals and the national job placement average of 45–50 percent. DCCC’s job placement rate is at 46 percent, as reported below in the outcomes section. That percentage is taken from the pool of participants that enrolled, as opposed to those who successfully completed their work experience. Of the participants that successfully completed their subsidized placement (i.e., work experience), 84 percent have gained employment.

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Track 2: GED or other occupational training – DC Career Connections

Narrative: For Occupational Training, DC Career Connections is slightly below target agency goals and the national job placement average. DCCC’s job placement rate is at 36 percent for those that earned an industry-recognized occupational credential. The percentage below is taken from the pool of participants that enrolled in occupational skills training, as opposed to those who successfully completed their training. Of the participants that successfully completed their training, 50 percent gained employment.

C. DCIA

Washington Gas Program Narrative: DCIA is currently working with our partner, Washington Gas, to identify training providers with experience working in the natural gas industry. The goal is to have a provider selected and the first cohort of participants complete training in Q1 2020. For these reasons, there is no data readily available to present.

3. Flagger training (Training Zone, others) – DCIA

Narrative: Employment data was pulled solely from data bump with employers in DC; thus, it may not accurately reflect the real employment number of OSHA – 10 and Flagger participants in the DC metropolitan area.

4. Pepco program (Quick Path) – DCIA

Narrative: The FY18 Pepco training program was not fully managed by DCIA, but transitioned to its control in FY18. The first Pepco cohort that was administered by DCIA began in March 2019 and ended August 2019. Credential and employment data does not accurately reflect DCIA’s efforts as training program completion leads to industry-recognized credentials. Upon receiving industry-recognized credentials, participants are then eligible for employment in the appropriate industry.

5. IT Programs (CC Prep, OIC, others) – DCIA

Narrative: Based on the Council provided definition, out of the 50 participants who completed in FY18, 17 were unable to pass one or both 900 series examinations, and 25 were unresponsive to all attempts made by workforce development case managers, such as calls, emails, and letters. While only eight of the 50 confirmed receiving CompTIA A+ certification, the agency's Wage Bump reports that 24 of the 50 are gainfully employed. The Wage Bump is only able to review employment in the District of Columbia, which may not accurately reflect employment in Virginia, a hub for the information technology.

6. CDL program (CDL CLASS – B) – DCIA

Narrative: The inaugural DCIA CDL Class B training program was a partnership with the Department of Public Works that began in April of FY18. There are various levels to receiving a CDL Class B Driver's License, which includes classroom instruction, passing a physical and drug test, obtaining a DOT card, getting a learner's permit, and earning enough behind-the-wheel hours before being able to take the road test. In FY19, the vendor did not begin services until July 1st, so participants were not captured in the date range requested. The class began with 15 participants.

8. Back to Work 50+ - Local Adult

Narrative: The Back to Work 50+ program was launched in May 2017. There were just four months of recruitment and programming during FY17. The number of total enrollees for FY18 reflects the first full fiscal year of enrollment. For FY19, there was a more targeted recruitment approach in an effort to ensure participants were enrolling in programming that best fit their needs. Prior to the start of FY19, it was recognized that through a more targeted approach, enrollment numbers may decrease, so the internal benchmark was reduced from 100 to 75 for each fiscal year. For FY2019, to-date enrollment has reached 66 enrollees.

In regards to achieving employment, it is helpful to note that there is some degree of attrition between those who enroll and those who complete the program. Attrition among Back to Work 50+ participants is more likely to be attributed to participant health and familial obligations leaving little likelihood that the participant reengages and therefor never obtains employment.

Narrative: This was not a standalone program. This was a code used for initiatives throughout the agency.

13. Ready to Work (DCCK, LAYC, SOME, others) – Local Adult

Narrative: In FY17 and FY18, the agency recruited applicants for the Strategic Innovation Programming Initiative. The initiative is a competitive, structured workforce development program under the Workforce Development Division. The Initiative offered four strategic categories: Connect DC, Ready-To-Work Transition Initiative, Housing Pathway for Homeless Youth, and Suit Up.

In addition to the Ready-To-Work component of the Innovation Initiative, the agency awarded two Suit Up grants to two Community Based Organizations (CBO) that were tasked to provide clothing assistance to the hard-to-serve and or special populations, including dislocated workers, homeless citizens, returning citizens, minorities and women, veterans, citizens with disabilities, and citizens with limited English proficiency. Between the two CBOs, there were a total of 856 participants that obtained business attire during the FY18 program period. The clothing dissemination was offered through Pop Up-Clothing Closets that were housed in two of DOES' AJC locations: NE and SE. The Pop Up-Clothing Closets were created to provide accessibility and convenience to DC residents.

Even though, there were some highlights throughout the grant period, the grantees were faced with many challenges with meeting the 60 percent performance outcome of participants obtaining job placement. Some of the challenges that the grantees noted were as follows:

- LAYC stated that they had challenges with keeping the young adults engaged during the summer breaks;
- DCCK noted that many of the participants were employed but the employment did not meet the guidelines of the grant to work 32 hours or more per week. It was noted that many of the participants chose to work part-time; and
- THRIVE DC enrolled many of their participants while they were still incarcerated to assist with the transition of being released. As a result, however, many of the women upon release dealt with challenges related to housing, childcare, and other supportive services that hindered them from obtaining employment.

Consequently, the grants were based on outcomes and the grantees were not able to take advantage of the full cost of their award.
