

**Eleven US Senate seats that Democrats may pick up in 2020
DFA 2020 Elections Task Force, July 15th, 2020**

Current Senate: 53 Republicans, 47 Democrats (including 2 Independents)

Democrats in 2020 are defending 12 seats, Republicans are defending 22 seats. Democrats need to pick up 3 or 4 seats to regain the majority but could pick up as many as 11 (see new Democrats in bold below). The \$ sign indicates they need financial support.

Arizona is the last state still waiting for its primary (P).
