



# Reopen Camberwell Station

## To the House of Commons.

The petition of residents of London, declares that the re-opening of Camberwell rail station, which sits on the Thameslink Line and is located on Camberwell Station Road, London SE5 9JJ, would come as welcome relief to poor transport links for years, especially following the disappointment of the proposal for the Bakerloo Line extension not to go through Camberwell, and with the ongoing disruption to Southern Rail services; further that the proposal is supported by nearby King's College Hospital, which employs thousands of staff and for whom constraints in local public transport capacity create significant issues in getting staff, patients and visitors to the hospital; further that when in office, then Mayor of London, stated that initial feasibility studies indicated it would be possible to construct a modern station at this location if timetable changes could be made to accommodate an extra stop.

**The petitioners therefore request that the House of Commons urges the Government to re-open Camberwell Station, London.**
