

25-27 February Stem Cell Training Course:

Do you want to learn to grow human embryonic stem cells (hESC)?

The NSW Stem Cell Network together with the Diabetes Transplant Unit, Prince of Wales Hospital, is presenting an intensive 3 day training course to teach qualified scientists the skills required to grow human embryonic stem cells.

This hands-on course includes professional course notes and training by **Dr Kuldip Sidhu**, who undertook advanced training in hESC cell culturing at WiCell in Wisconsin in 2003. The course is available for groups of up to 6 people. Tissue culture experience is a prerequisite. The cost is \$1,500 / person (GST inclusive).
