Sea Breeze is looking to have a parklet outside their restaurant during the warm months. The Greater Ashmont Beautification and Public Spaces committee is working to help them navigate the city process as one of the biggest pieces of feedback from the Dot Ave visioning session was the need for outdoor seating and vibrancy on the avenue. For those of you unfamiliar with parklets, it's a simple structure that helps extend the footprint of their dining space to have outdoor seating. It removes two parking spaces outside their restaurant and replaces it with a city-owned HDPE structure where patrons can eat, etc. Alcohol is not allowed in the parklet and cleanup etc is to be provided by Sea Breeze. It would be there just for the months where outdoor seating is weather appropriate. A letter of support from St Marks Civic would be hugely helpful in getting through the city approval process. I understand the next meeting isn't until the end of the month, but we were hoping to help them through the approval process soon so the structure could be in place for the bulk of the summer.
