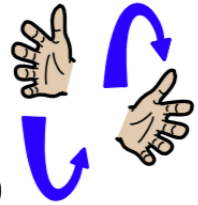
Drop-in advocacy support for hard of hearing, elderly deafened, d/Deaf or deafblind residents of Trafford.

(excluding Thursday 29th October)



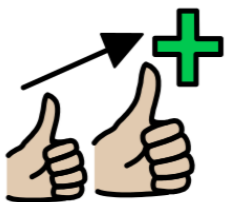
Where?
