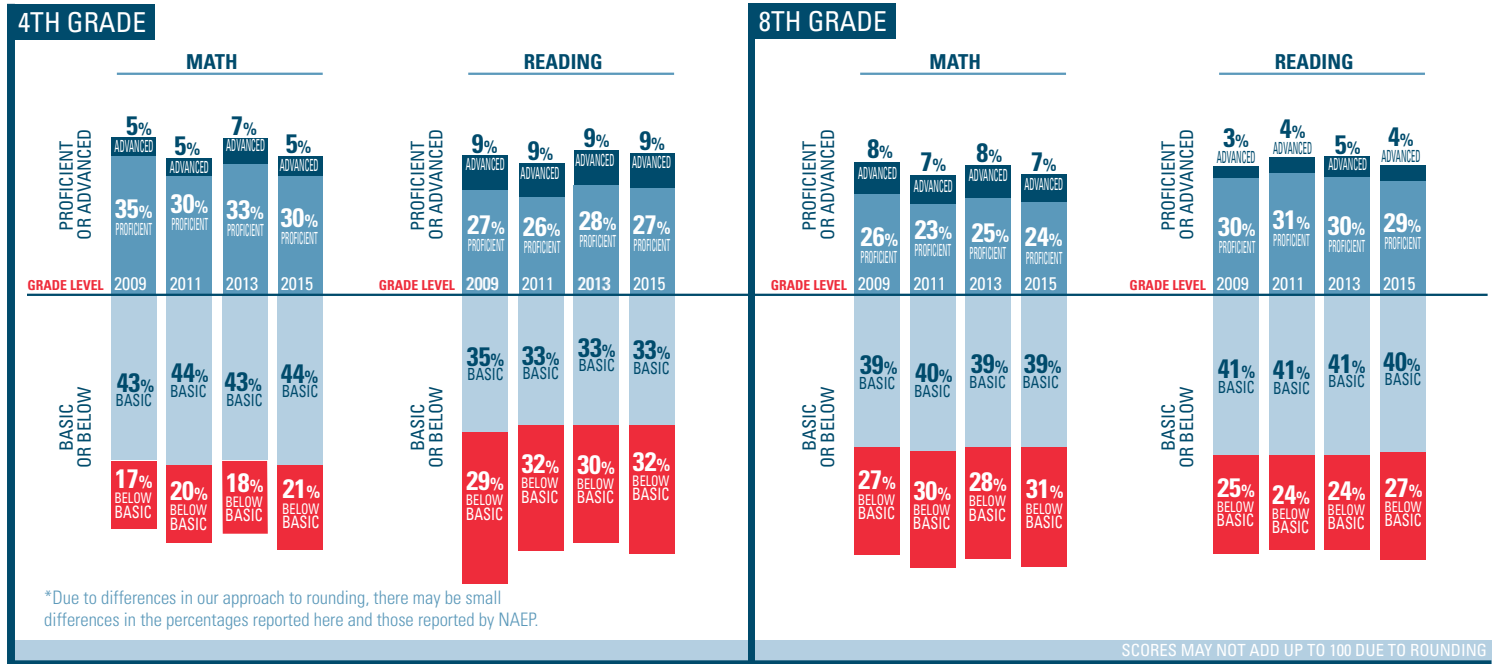
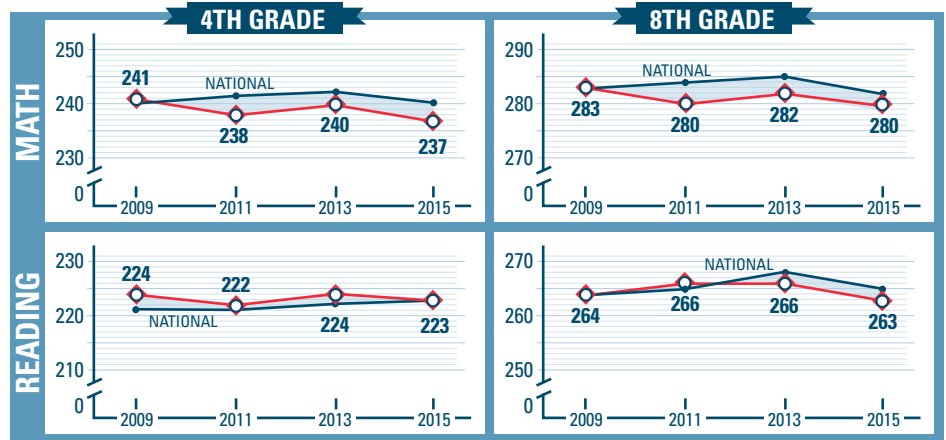


PROFICIENCY COMPARISON The National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) is a nationally representative and continuing assessment of what America's students know and can do in different grades and subjects. In 2015, the percentage of New York students scoring proficient or better decreased in all tested grade levels and subjects. More than 60% of students in New York still scored below proficient levels in math and/or reading in 2015.



SCALE SCORE COMPARISON

These graphs show the trend in scale scores since 2009. Scale scores summarize the level of performance attained by a student on a scale of 0-500, and are reported by student group. In 2015, average scale scores decreased in all tested grade levels and subjects. New York's scale scores are about the same as the national average in 4th and 8th grade reading and 8th grade math, but remain below average for 4th grade math.



STUDENT GROUPS

This graphic shows the percentage of students who scored at a basic or below basic level compared to those who have scored proficient or advanced. There are stark achievement gaps for Black, Hispanic, and ELL students, as well as students who qualify for FRL.

NAEP RANKINGS Below are the state rankings for 4th and 8th grade reading and math. New York 8th graders are ranked 33rd in the country, and 4th graders in the state are ranked 28th in reading and 39th in the country in math, which puts New York in the bottom half of states in all subjects and grade levels.
