You know funders are out there. Foundation Directory Online (FDO), the most extensive, up-to-date database of philanthropic giving, can show you where they are, and help you win more funding from them.

To start your search, simply describe:

What you need funding for: mission, goals, or desired outcomes.

Where you need funding: city, metro area, congressional district, county, state, country, or continent.

Who you serve: age, sex, socioeconomic, race/ethnicity, gender /sexual identity, or religion.

Example searches: Ballet school in New York City; Animal Shelter in Portland, ME; Food pantry in Baltimore, MD.
