"Vision Zero Cleveland is an initiative of the City of Cleveland and Cleveland City Council, in partnership with local agencies and community groups, working to eliminate all traffic fatalities and severe injuries.

To help support safe, healthy, and equitable mobility for all Clevelanders, Vision Zero Cleveland is creating an Action Plan to build a transportation network in Cleveland based on a "Safe Systems Approach" – one that layers and leverages the shared responsibility of those involved in the



transportation network to eliminate deaths and serious injuries. A Safe Systems Approach makes it safe for everyone to move through the city whether they are walking, rolling, or in a vehicle.
