

Peace for Pekapeka Hikoi — Wednesday 21st September Timetable and Useful Information

Kia ora all -

Please share and promote the following to your whānau and networks, to help ease any confusion around timeframes of the Peace for Pekapeka Hikoi.

- Gathering from 9.30am at Te Kohia Pa site (Brixton), turn onto Raleigh Street off the Main Highway and look for a group of people gathered!
- 10am: Hikoi commences through to Owae Marae, via the Waitara township.
- 11.45am-12noon (approx): Hikoi is welcomed onto Owae Marae.
- 1pm: The Community Conversation commences in Te Ikaroa a Maui (Wharenui).

Please note:

- For those who may not be able to walk, please gather at Owae from 11.30am onwards, and join the Hikoi as it welcomed onto the Marae.
- For those who are able to attend the Community Conversation only, please be at Owae by 12.45pm.
- There will be two vans that can help take people back to collect cars from Te Kohia at the end of the Community Conversation.
- Any kai koha can be taken to the Marae prior to the Hikoi arriving.
- The Hikoi is just over 5km, so please bring sensible and suitable footwear.
